Images of the paintings were recreated on framed, sound-absorbing panels that are suspended from the ceiling to create a beautiful canopy of lowcountry scenes.

We are simply overjoyed with the results and thrilled that their guests will be surrounded by the beauty of the lowcountry created by our artists.
